Qualifications:

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen; hold a valid Wisconsin drivers license; be able to perform essential functions of a police officer; possess an Associate's Degree in criminal justice or a related field (a Bachelor's Degree is desirable); L.E.S.B certification; several years of progressively responsible law enforcement experience; previous investigatory training and / or experience is desirable; good physical conditioning; or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
