## Do I need a permit?

**Yes!**

A HVAC permit is required for the installation of any wood, gas, pellet, or corn fired stove or fireplace.

Permit fees are based on the retail cost of an installed appliance or the retail cost of the materials x 2.

Permit fees are as follows:

\$100-1000

\$50

\$1,001-10,000

\$50 plus \$1.25 per additional \$100

\$10,000-25,000

\$275 plus \$1.00 per additional \$100

\$25,001 & over

\$500 plus \$.75 per additional \$100

## Exterior Wood Fired Boilers

Per municipal ordinance 14.01(1)c :  
No person shall install, use, or maintain an outdoor wood burning heating system in the Village of North Fond du Lac.

## Stove/fireplace

### DO's

**Do** make sure that an appliance is listed for installation in a manufactured or mobile home.

**Do** make sure there is proper clearance between the appliance and combustible walls, ceilings, and floors.

**Do** install the appliance on a fireproof base.

**Do** burn only dry, seasoned wood or the proper fuel for your appliance.

**Do** have a mason inspect your existing chimney if it is being utilized by the new appliance.

## Stove/fireplace

### DON'TS

**Don't** use the appliance unless it is installed per the UL approved listing and/or the Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code.

**Don't** burn trash in an appliance, it may cause a chimney fire.

**Don't** mix solid fuel burning appliance and gas fired appliance chimneys together.

**Don't** extend a chimney pipe through a wall or ceiling unless an approved thimble is being utilized.
