On Wednesday, March 14, 2007, a 14 year-old boy told North Fond du Lac police that he had seen a vehicle matching the description of the car a 9 year-old girl reported had approached her on February 28. The boy said he saw an older green passenger car with a racing bumper sticker, beanie babies in the rear window, and black and white dice hanging from the rear view mirror. He told police he saw the vehicle at approximately 2:40pm Wednesday afternoon on Michigan Avenue near Garfield Street. The boy said the car was being driven by a white male, approximately 18-20 years-old, and he did not see any other passengers in the vehicle. The boy also told police the first three characters of the license plate were "101," but he could not recall any of the letters or other digits.
