

**AN EMERGENCY DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE
OF NORTH FOND DU LAC**

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has identified the potential public health threat posed by COVID-19 both globally and in the United States as “high”, and has advised that person-to-person spread of COVID-19 will continue to occur within the United States, and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death, and is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been previously identified in humans and can easily spread from person to person.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare and good order of the Village to proclaim that a state of emergency exists in the Village of North Fond du Lac and it is necessary to temporarily suspend or modify applicable ordinances or resolutions to allow immediate response to meet the needs of the extraordinary existing conditions as follows:

- Amend Village Ordinance 2.02(3) to allow all Village Board members, staff and meeting participants to participate in meetings thru remote access, including providing access online to the public until December 31, 2020 or sooner if the emergency state is resolved.*
- Amend Ordinance 2.02(3) and 2.03(a) Quorum to allow quorum to be created by online appearances by Village Board members until December 31, 2020 or sooner if the emergency state is resolved.*
- Allow all Village Boards and Commissions to meet thru remote access and to count online appearances toward quorum until December 31, 2020 or sooner if the emergency state is resolved.*
- Pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 323.52, amend the location of the governmental meetings of the Village of North Fond du Lac temporarily to be hosted online electronically if needed until December 31, 2020 or sooner if the emergency state is resolved.*
- Allow the Village President to exercise all necessary and expedient powers pursuant to Section 323.14(4), Wis. Stats. until December 31, 2020 or sooner if the emergency state is resolved.*

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 323.11 and 323.14(4), Wis. Stats., as Village President of the Village of North Fond du Lac I sign and certify this Declaration of Emergency.

**VILLAGE OF NORTH FOND DU LAC
PROCLAMATION OF THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT
MARCH 22, 2020**

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2020 the Village President of the Village of North Fond du Lac Declared a State of Emergency in the Village of North Fond du Lac; and

WHEREAS, the emergency power granted to the governing body by Wis. Stat. 323.14(4)(a) includes general authority to order, by ordinance or resolution, whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons and property within the local unit of government in the emergency; and

WHEREAS, if because of the emergency conditions, the governing body of the local unit of government is unable to meet promptly, the Emergency Declaration and Wis. Stat. 323.14(4)(b) grants the Village President the authority to act under Wis. Stats. 323.11 and 323.14(4)(a)

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT DOES HEREBY PROCLAIM THAT:

1. All late fees and credit card fees imposed by the village shall be waived.
2. All benefit eligible employees will receive eighty (80) hours of emergency leave, or its equivalent for 24-hour shift employees, subject to terms and conditions as determined by the Human Resources Department. Part-time employees will receive a pro-rated amount of emergency leave.
3. All employees shall be required to notify the Human Resources Department if they engage in any travel outside the State of Wisconsin. The Village Administrator or their designee shall then determine the employee's eligibility to return to work and benefit eligibility.
4. All employees shall refer to the document "Village of North Fond du Lac Contingency Policy for Employees Regarding Coronavirus (COVID-19)" dated March 22, 2020 for further details regarding work policy during this State of Emergency.
5. Effective March 22, 2020, at 4:30 p.m. until further notice, all non-essential Village services and public access to municipal facilities shall be suspended, with the exception of:
 - a. Village Hall will remain open to the public as currently required by state law for purposes of voter registration and voting.
6. Meetings of all Village governmental bodies shall be at the call of the body Chair, or President.
7. If any meeting of the Village Board is cancelled, the Village Administrator or Deputy Treasurer shall be authorized to pay such vouchers and invoices as were set for

approval at the cancelled meeting, subject to ratification by the Village Board at the next meeting.

8. Any ordinance, resolution or policy in conflict with the above proclamation shall be superseded by this proclamation.
9. The above proclamations shall remain in effect until the Declaration of a State of Emergency is no longer in effect, or until ratified, altered, modified, or repealed by the Village Board at any meeting.
